The results are good

In May 2019, we completed the logging, sampling and assaying of ~38 km of diamond core at our Mt Wills Gold Mines (Mt Wills) Project. The results so far confirm the value of the re-logging and resampling of the historic core; reporting extremely high grades of Gold (Au) and Silver (Ag).

From these works we have also identified a number of previously unsampled mineralized zones presenting a significant benefit to this Project.

Additional Exploration (including infill drilling) at Mt Wills is scheduled to commence late Q3 / early Q4, 2019.

Low-impact exploration program

We have received the relevant approvals from DELWP and acknowledgement from ERR, Heritage Victoria and Aboriginal Victoria to undertake our Low Impact Exploration Program at Mt Wills, including environmental baseline monitoring and underground 'infill' drilling works. We have commenced preparations and will be beginning these low-impact exploration works in September 2019. We will continue to keep the community updated with our progress.



Licensing update

In June 2019, we submitted our Mining Licence Renewal for MIN 4921 at Mt Wills and our application for Exploration License EL 006728 at Cassilis.

We're expecting to receive feedback on these in the coming months.

- **July**
Stage 1 rectification and make-safe works commence on Level 5 adit at Mt Wills.
Heritage Management Plans for Mt Wills and Cassilis Historic areas completed.
- **August**
Updated JORC Report and Resource Model finalised.
Consolidation / Modernisation Exploration Work Plan for Mt Wills submitted to ERR.
- **September**
Commence Low-impact exploration, underground drilling works and environmental baseline monitoring programs at Mt Wills.
